



### Minorities Club



- The citizens of minorities do not have the registration of clubs apart from the Romany citizens. The Romany association acting in the administrative district of the City of Most: Sdružení Romů města Mostu (Most Romany Association) o.s., and Community Centre Chánov (Komunitní Centrum Chánov).
- In 2007 an interest of Romany youth increased in the use. They started to come to the Minorities Club every afternoon for the programme „Romany Club for Children from Elementary Schools“. This programme was selected to the sample projects funded from the European Social Fund in the years 2005 – 2007 and was included in the book of good practises examples. The subsequent project has been implemented in the Minorities Club "Prevention of Social Exclusion in Romany Localities" which extends to the coexistence of children with parents in the family.





### Community Plan of social welfare services in Most



- In April 2007 the City Representatives approved the executive plan of social welfare services which is an amendment of the Community Plan of social welfare services in Most for the period 2006 – 2010 which within its measures, defines field social work for ethnic and national minorities as a necessary activity.
- From the beginning the organizations focused on the support of ethnic and national minorities (most frequently Romany) being involved in the process of community planning. These organizations regularly meet in the group No.5 – Ethnic and national minorities. The group has 7 members – representatives of the organizations the projects of which are described in detail in the Community Planning of the City of Most and in which the City of Most co-partners with funding.

**For the period 2006 – 2010 the Most City Council established the Committee of Minorities as its advisory body**



The Committee discusses the matters related to the minorities and foreigners and monitors the integration of Romany community members. External advisors and minorities are represented in the committee (Hungarian, Jewish and Bulgarian).

- The coordinator of minorities from the Most Municipality informs about the solved agendas and requirements of minorities and asylum seekers.
- She informs the committee about the integration of Romany communities and crime prevention (which is provided by the city in cooperation with the Municipal Police and the Police of the Czech Republic).
- She informs about the work of the field workers in the Minorities Club, which is mainly focused on the areas of social support, civil coexistence, accommodation and job opportunities.
- Every year the Minorities Committee recommends financial gifts from the city budget for approval to the Most City Council to provide cultural and sports traditions of minorities.
